Failure to do so will likely forfeit your paper acceptance. Please continue to check the conference website <https://icraie.nitk.ac.in/> for all updates.

1. Only the registered author(s) for this paper will receive this letter and the enclosed material. If there are other authors, please share this correspondence with them. Names of all authors will appear in the Conference Guide and the ICRAIE-2022 Proceedings.
2. The reviews for your research paper can be viewed at the CMT paper submission page, <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICRAIE2022/>. Please login to view the reviews. Please consider the comments provided by the reviewers and revise your paper based on the comments. The camera ready version of the paper must be prepared in accordance with the "Author Instructions" appended with this email.
3. The number of author(s) and their ordering in CRC should match exactly as declared in CMT at submission time. Any violation will result in rejection of paper.
4. The conference program and additional information regarding the conference will be posted on the conference website <https://icraie.nitk.ac.in/> soon.

Final Paper Submission Instructions for Authors of 2022 IEEE ICRAIE

Authors, please complete the following steps by **15th October 2022**

1. Prepare your camera ready version, including the IEEE copyright notice.
2. PDF eXpress Plus Online File Conversion/PDF Validation Tool.
3. Complete and submit one IEEE copyright form per paper.
4. Camera ready Paper PDF File Submission.

1. Prepare your final version, including the IEEE copyright notice

Formatting Instructions:

Papers should not exceed SIX pages, including figures, tables and references.

A maximum of 2 extra pages are allowed at the rate of INR500 per page for Indian authors and USD25 for foreign authors. IEEE is strict about the requirements for PDF files for inclusion in the IEEE Xplore® Digital Library. Format your paper according to IEEE conference style guidelines. MS Word and Latex templates can be found at <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates.html>. Use the A4 format. DO NOT use the US Letter format and do not paginate your paper.

IEEE Copyright notice

Add the IEEE Copyright Notice in the footer section to the bottom of the first page of your paper, prior to creating the final PDF version. Choose the appropriate notice from the following:

- For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright.
- For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: 978-1-6654-9781-7/22/\$31.00 ©2022 Crown
- For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is: 978-1-6654-9781-7/22/\$31.00 ©2022 European Union
- For all other papers the copyright notice is: 978-1-6654-9781-7/22/\$31.00 ©2022 IEEE

If using LaTeX IEEEtran class the following script placed before the `\begin{document}` statement will insert the copyright notice in the right place.

2. PDF eXpress Plus Online File Conversion/PDF Validation Tool

All papers submitted for publication must meet the IEEE standards. Access to PDF eXpress Plus site, the IEEE's online file conversion/PDF validation tool, will assist authors in preparing suitable electronic files of their final papers. PDF eXpress Plus helps authors convert their papers into IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF files (conversion function) or to check their own PDF files for IEEE Xplore compatibility (PDF validation function).

All final manuscripts must be generated using the PDF eXpress tool. Submit your final, ready-for-publication paper at <https://ieee-pdf-express.org/>. If you are a new user to IEEE PDF eXpress, you must set up an account before uploading your paper. **Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.**

To generate the IEEE Xplore compatible PDF file of your paper, follow these steps:

- i. Create your IEEE PDF eXpress Plus account: <https://ieee-pdf-express.org/>

- ii. Conference ID: 56454X

- iii. The first time you access the system, please follow the link to new user. Please note that in order to access the service, you need to allow the use of cookies from the PDF eXpress web site. Once you have registered as a new user:

- a. Upload the source file (containing your paper) for conversion.
- b. Receive by e-mail the IEEE Xplore-compatible PDF of your paper.

Renaming your PDF File for Submission

The certified acceptable file you receive from PDF eXpress will be given a filename in the form PID123.pdf. You should rename this exact file to conform to the following naming convention: ICRAIE2022paperID.pdf, where the paperID is the ICRAIE-2022 paper ID assigned to the submission by CMT.

3. Complete and submit one IEEE copyright form per paper

IEEE policy requires that every submitted paper must be accompanied by a signed IEEE Copyright Form before publication can occur. The electronic copyright submission form will walk you through the steps to complete and submit the IEEE copyright form for your paper. Only one form is required per paper. You will find the link to the e-COPYRIGHT FORM once you log in to the conference paper submission site, <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICRAIE2022/>

Papers with more than one identified Corresponding Author will receive only one email regarding e-Copyright Form submission.

Please ensure that the title of your research paper is correct and that the author names and the affiliation details are correctly recorded in the CMT system before completing the IEEE electronic copyright form. You will not be able to change/edit the form once it is submitted.

4. Final Paper PDF File Submission

Submit your paper through PDF eXpress Plus and when you are happy with the PDF file, click on the "approve for collection" link. Rename your file as explained in Step 2.

Deadline for CRC Submission: October 15, 2022. This is a hard deadline for revised papers to be included in the ICRAIE-2022 Proceedings on IEEE Xplore. Please also

submit the camera-ready paper the conference paper submission site, <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/ICRAIE2022/> by october 15, 2022.

5. Register for the Conference

Only Registered and Presented Papers will be submitted for publication in ICRAIE 2022 Proceedings and will be sent to IEEE Xplore. Registration link will be emailed separately. Instructions for uploading presentation and Video recording will be provided after the registration.

Policy on Plagiarism

All papers submitted to ICRAIE-2022 will be checked for plagiarism, inappropriate multiple submission, and inappropriate use of previous work.
